Scriptural Insight: 1 Nephi 13:37

1) Announcement: Phone Usage

Take responsibility for helping your missionaries with their phones. Make sure to help them be accountable for their data usage in their district council.

2) Zone Barriers/Solutions

Bantama: Problem is putting people on baptism date AND baptizing them. This past week was a Stake Conference so we focused on helping all our zone members be looking forward to the next. Discussed ideas with district leaders to help all of those on date to be baptized on the 27th and 28th of April.

Meduma: Helping our sisters to work with the members, helping to connect those on date with members to ensure they progress to the waters of baptism.

Bibiani: Discussed with our district leaders on how we could increase the number of lessons with members, resulting in an increase of lessons with members across the zone. We also sent a document out to the members of our zone to help them.

Ejisu: To help with potential people at church we focused on teaching covenants, so our investigators understand why they are coming to church. Baptismal date we need to follow up on, the same with new people.

Konongo: We focused on new people being taught. We did this through lessons with members. We discussed with our district leaders how we can improve, and asked them to review a document we made in district council. We also talked about the importance of working with the ward/branch leadership.

University Sisters: Find when we are teaching. Inviting all that we are teaching to bring their friends. Focusing on family members, having family members invite each other to church. Meeting with the bishop to discuss finding efforts.

Obuasi: Seeking through PMG to help our missionaries set baptismal dates. Focusing on helping them plan, so that they can know when to put someone on date. Going through their areas on PMG app, and looking at those on date, encouraging the missionaries to be focusing their efforts on those on date.

Suame: Working with our District Leaders, focusing on accomplishing the goals that we set. Focusing on working with members to help achieve our goals. The missionaries that had lessons with members are those that have people on date.

Afrancho: Sustain the ZLs

Sunyani: We helped our zone focus on strengthening the members, helping them to grow their faith. This helped us to get more lessons with members, and helped us connect our investigators with members. Asked our district leaders to focus on working with members. When there's less progress, there needs to be more goals set.

Techiman Sisters: Calling each companionship, making sure they are focused. Using exchanges as a way to teach best practices, following up with phone calls.

Tamale: Lessons with members, Baptismal Date, New People. We talked with our district leaders to help focus our efforts to achieve our goal as a zone.

Techiman: To find more new people we assigned our district leaders to call their district members daily, to follow up on finding 1 serious person daily. We have reinforced this focus by assigning our district leaders to go through the 9 points of finding in district council tomorrow.

President: Continue to follow up with district leaders

University: Putting people on date is our problem. We will discuss this problem tomorrow in district council meeting.
